ENSEMBLES

Performing is an essential element of music education. All students are strongly encouraged to participate in ensembles coached by CCM Prep and Collegiate faculty. Ensembles are available for young people who play strings, winds, brass, jazz and singers. Adult ensembles include CCM Community Women's Choir, CCM New Horizons Orchestra and Jazz Combos.

MUSIC THEORY CLASSES

Music theory is essential to a music students' training. Students enrolled in theory classes have access to the CCM technology labs, and students enrolled in private lessons at CCM Prep receive a discount for theory classes. A theory test determines proper placement. We offer music theory classes for youth and adults and music theory classes for ensemble musicians.

PRIVATE LESSONS

The core of our music program is private lessons with our talented and experienced faculty. CCM Prep teachers follow a curriculum developed by our faculty that includes musical and technical skills for each level, suggested repertoire and additional learning experiences. Most of our teachers use their own training, experience, knowledge and talent to teach students.

SUZUKI MUSIC LESSONS (cello, piano, violin and viola)

The Suzuki Method, developed by Dr. Shinichi Suzuki, is based on the evidence that talent is a product of environment rather than heredity. The learning process is broken down into small steps so that the student achieves accomplishment at every level and learns at their own pace.







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
